

DID YOU KNOW?

1 Say “yes” to organ and tissue donation every time you *apply for or renew* your New Jersey driver license or state ID card. The words “Organ Donor” will appear on the front of your license and will be included in your computer record with the Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC).



2 Or you can visit www.donatelifenj.org anytime to join the online donor registry through MVC. The online donor registry enables all New Jersey residents, with a state-issued license or ID, age 18 or older, to register their decision to be an organ and tissue donor. This decision qualifies as legal documentation of gift that cannot be revoked by anyone but you.

3 Discuss your decision to be a donor with your family, now, while you can.

4 The “Donate Life” license plate, featuring the Gift of Life Rose is available for purchase at your local Motor Vehicle Agency.



5 Over 110,000 Americans are waiting for a transplant. 4,700 are New Jersey residents.

6 18 people die each day waiting for a life-saving transplant.

7 You can bring life-saving information about organ and tissue donation to your local high school or college! Contact info@sharenj.org to find out more about the “High School Heroes” program or our College Outreach Initiative.



8 You can designate funds on New Jersey’s individual income tax form to support organ and tissue donation education programs.
